

 - Tasmaniaand 2 major territories
 - Northern Territory
 - Australian Capital Territory
- the capital is Canberra

GEOGRAPHY




- Nearly half of the continent occupies **Great Western Plateau** on the west
- In the central part there are 3 big deserts
 - **Great Sandy Desert**
 - **the Gibson Desert**
 - **the Great Victoria Desert**
- Central Lowlands are mostly covered by tropical forests and savannah
- There are 3 large lakes
 - **Lake Eyre**
 - **Lake Torrens**
 - **Lake Gairdner**
- In the east there is **the Great Dividing Range** and the **Australian Alps** with the highest Australian mountain **Mount Kosciuszko** (2228 m)

- many of Australia's rivers are filled with water only during rainy seasons
- the biggest rivers are **the Murray** flowing from the New South Wales to the Indian Ocean and **the Darling**



CLIMATE, FAUNA AND FLORA

- Australia has many different kinds of climate
 - tropical in the north, arid in the centre, sub-tropical or temperate in the rest of the continent



Didgeridoo is traditional Aboriginal musical instrument






SPORTS, INDUSTRY, RAW MATERIALS


