LOCATION




- Canada is situated in North America.


PEOPLE, LANGUAGES, CITIES

- population of 33 million
- most people live in the cities along the USA-Canada border
- the north of Canada is not so populated because of harsh conditions
- original settlers were mostly of British and French origin
- the original inhabitants are Inuits and Indians
- 60 % of population speak English, about 30 % speak French
- the capital is Ottawa
- the largest city is Montreal which is the second largest French speaking city in the world after Paris





GOVERNMENT, ECONOMY, INDUSTRY

- the seat of parliament and government is in Ottawa
- Canada is part of the British Commonwealth, it's an independent confederation with parliamentary democracy
- the official head of state is the Queen Elizabeth II, in Canada represented by the Governor General,
the leading figure in political life is the Prime Minister
- Canada is rich in raw materials (uranium, gold, silver, iron, copper, oil, coal, zinc, lead)
- almost half of Canada is covered by forest, so wood industry is important as well as paper industry, food industry, machine building, ship building, engineering and fishing
- the main trading partner is the USA

SPORT

- sport plays an important role in Canada
- Hockey, which was invented there, is the most popular spectator sport
- Lacrosse, a sport with aboriginal origins, is Canada's oldest sport and official summer sport, Canadian football, is also popular



NATIONAL SYMBOLS, FLAG

- Official symbols of canada include maple leaf, beaver and the canadian Horse
- Syrup is very popular in canada, it's made from the sap of the maple tree
- The flag is red-white with the national symbol ofthe maple leaf
- The Canadian anthem is called „O Canada“
