

- fortification of Roman Britain
- ordered to be built by Roman Emperor Hadrian around 122 AD to protect Britain against enemies



GIANT'S CAUSEWAY

- natural wonder formed by hexagonal columns of basalt rock as a result of an ancient volcanic eruption




- located on the northeast coast of the Northern Ireland

- also departure and return point of Sir Christopher Drake's voyage around the world






BATH
