HOUSING AND LIVING - Teachers' notes:

Aim:

To practice vocabulary connected with the topic of Housing and living

Materials:

1 handout for a group of 4-6 students

Instructions:

- Cut the handouts into pieces to get 'dominoes' cards.
- Students work in groups of 4-6. The students divide the cards so that each student gets a proportional number of the cards. Remind the students <u>not</u> to show their cards to their classmates.
- Tell the students to take turns reading the right part of the cards, i.e. the beginnings of the compound nouns/set phrases.
- Other students listen and try to find an expression to complete the compound noun/set phrase.
- In the end, tell the students to place the cards in a dominoe chain.

Extension:

- Students explain the meaning of the individual expressions in English.
- Students use the expressions in sentences.
- Students think of possible questions to ask their classmates to learn something about them.
 (The expressions from the cards should be included in the questions.) Students then take turns asking and answering the questions.
