TRAVELLING / TRANSPORT – Vocabulary

1.1 Means of transport

kinds of transport: personal vs. freight transport – private vs. public transport – land vs. air vs. sea transport

means of transport: aeroplane (BrE) – airplane (AmE) – balloon – bicycle – boat – car – coach – ferry – motorbike – motorcycle (AmE) – ocean liner – ship – train – tram – truck – underground – yacht

adjectives: cheap – comfortable – eco-friendly – quick – safe

verbs / v. phrases: be afraid of – be afraid that ... – feel seasick – fly – get around on foot – go by ... – ride a bike/motorbike/horse – travel abroad – travel round the country

1.2 (My) way home from school

arrive at / in – bus stop – come to – commute – drive – get on / get off – get to – go by – go on foot – ride a bike/motorbike – rush – (train) station – stay at the boarding house – take (some time)

1.3 (My) dream holiday destination

be interested in – dream holiday destination – want to go and see

1.4 (My) last summer holiday / (my) plans for this summer

I (did sth) / (went somewhere)

I am going (to do sth) I hope (to do sth) – I want to improve (sth) – I will (do sth)

1.5 Travelling abroad

credit card – money – passport – travel insurance – visa (*depends on the country*)

1.6 Problems that can occur while travelling abroad

be robbed – get lost – lose (sb's) luggage / passport

1.7 Advantages / disadvantages of travelling long distances by train

better for the environment (than planes) – get directly from one city centre to another – get up and move around whenever you want – see the countryside – more room / space (than on a bus) – slow(er) / (more) expensive (than other means of transport) – (sometimes) old / smelly – dirty

1.8 Advantages / disadvantages of travelling long distances by coach

(+) cheap(er) / fast(er) / (more) comfortable / (much) green(er) than flying – relax / enjoy the scenery – catch up on some sleep – reduce pollution – (be) safe – have toilets on board
(-) not have much leg room – break down – be cramped – get stuck in a traffic jam

1.9 Advantages / disadvantages of flying / travelling by plane

(+) fast – (quite) comfortable
(-) be afraid of flying – create(s) a lot of pollution – feel sick on board – flight can be cancelled / delayed – unexpected delay – stressful – health problems (stomach pain / ear problems / headache) – located out of the city

1.10 What to do when travelling by plane

arrive / be at the airport two hours before the plane leaves – check in (your) luggage – go through security – be charged an extra baggage fee (for extra baggage) – board a plane (v)

1.11 Advantages / disadvantages (drawbacks) of going by car / driving a car

(+) (it) allow(s) you to travel when and where you want – change your mind about your destination – listen to (your) music as loud as you like – stop when you want – take / bring lots of luggage
(-) (have to) find a place to park – (can) get stuck in a traffic jam

1.12 Advantages / disadvantages of public transport

(more) convenient – (be) crowded (with sb) – (more) economical – good (better) for the environment – (be) limited by the time schedule – public transport(ation) – transport company

1.13 Travelling by public transport

(some type of) monthly / seasonal / annual pass – receive a discount / concession – travel by any form / means of public transport – (single / one-way / return) ticket – (need) a valid ticket – tickets valid for a zone and/or time period

1.14 How to behave on public transport

signs posted on the (train / bus / tram) – tell (sb) not to do (sth) – not to talk loudly – not to wear dirty clothes – no seats left – offer your seat to an elderly or handicapped / disabled person or a pregnant woman – smoking is forbidden
